Which squares are available?

Maria-Theresien-Street

- north side in front of the Anna Column
- 2 in front of the Spitalskirche (not 6.00 7.00 pm due to Mass)

Old town

- 3 in front of the City Tower
- 4 intersection of Kiebachgasse / Seilergasse
- **5** Franziskaner Square

Other city squares

- **6** Waltherpark
- Get-together zone on Rennweg (Leopold Fountain, not 8.00 9.00 pm)
- 8 Wiltener Platzl (not on Saturday from 11-12 am, not on Sunday)

ATTENTION: If there is construction work in progress on one of the above-mentioned squares, or if another registered event is taking place there, there is no substitute provided.

Registration

- 1. Possibility of approval for a place ticket:
 - 1 day | 1 week
- 2. Maintenance:

The place tickets can be collected in person from the Citizens' Service or, if booked online, can be obtained via the website:

The place ticket (day ticket with name and date; weekly ticket with name and calendar week) must be carried in conjunction with an offical photo ID as confirmation during inspection.

Important: the issued place ticket must be carried and presented to the outhorities on request.

What else must be heeded?

Since some places are close to each other or other events are taking place nearby, music is only permitted with these instruments: string, woodwind and keyborad instruments, digeridoos, guiros, maracas, rattles.

- No permission is granted for making music with brass and percussion instruments
- Platforms and other superstructures are not permitted
- For each calender week, max. 2 week-tickets and 6 day-tickets will be awarded

Acoustic amplifiers are not permitted!
